Crow's Nest P-10 State School will receive

\$139,300*

This funding will be used to

- 100% of students in Years 3, 5, 7, 9 attain NMS in Reading and Spelling NAPLAN in 2017.
- 40% or better of students in Years 3, 5, 7, 9 attain U2B in Reading and Spelling NAPLAN in 2017.
- 95% of Prep to Year 9 students attain Regional Benchmarks by the end of 2017.
- 80% or better of students in all year levels achieve a C or higher in English, Mathematics and Science.

Our initiatives include

- Revising the school pedagogical framework using research-based model of Marzano – Art and Science of Teaching and embed it as the shared language of teaching and learning.
- Reducing number of students in Primary classes by creating an extra class.
- Providing focussed and intensive reading intervention for all identified students.
- Better preparing and supporting teacher aides to extend student learning in classes as required.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Creating an additional Primary class for 2017. | \$49,987.00 |
| • Providing additional teacher support for focussed and intensive intervention in reading for identified students. | \$25,000.00 |
| • Providing additional teacher aide time to support teachers and students from Prep - Year 10. | \$50,000.00 |
| • Professional development and training for teachers to review, develop and implement new Pedagogical Framework. | \$ 9,313.00 |
| • Professional development as required to support teacher aides to support intervention of identified students. | \$ 2,000.00 |
| • Purchasing replacement MiniLit/MultiLit/MacqLit resources to replenish resources used in 2016. | \$ 3,000.00 |
